We have reviewed the *Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)* and the Response to Submissions (RtS), for the Wentworthville Northside West Clinic Extension (SSD-17899480). The proposal development is for the construction an extension to the existing Wentworthville Northside West Clinic with alterations and additions to the existing building. The extension will include 95 inpatient rooms and 9 consulting suites.

The redevelopment is related to increased mental health care services and inpatient residential care for the Wentworthville Northside West Clinic and is not anticipated to store dangerous goods that exceed the SEPP 33 thresholds. As such we have no further comments on the proposed development.
