Apologies, I thought I had replied to Adam's comments previously.

The tree was identified as being of good form and vitality however mention has been made in the report that there is decay in a structural root and the tree is likely to be impacted by up to 25% which under AS4970 – Protection of Trees on Development this is considered to be a major incursion with minimal opportunity to add supplementary roots on the opposite side of the crown of the tree.

I would recommend removal and replacement with same species.

Hi Olivia and Stephen,

Further to discussions with Ingrid,

Council's Tree 47 root zone will be impacted (25%) by drainage works and the applicant is reluctant to accept inclusions of arborist report for tree outside of the development property.

I'm not sure whether I was aware of this at the time of referral or whether this was addressed by Charles or other tree officer. I believe we may have expected that it was satisfactorily addressed in the arborist report, however trees outside of the development property are currently excluded.

We need to reiterate that the findings of the arborist report is to be wholly applied to the development, including tree 47 or any other tree along the boundary of Council's Lytton Street Park that will be impacted, regardless.

To be super clear we should provide a condition to Ingrid, something like:

Root mapping shall be undertaken for trees that will be impacted by proposed development where situated along the boundary of Lytton Street Park and works assessed by the site arborist prior to any tree damaging activity is undertaken. The site arborist should assess the tree/s as either minor and not expected to impact the long term health of the tree, or major where impact to the long term health of the trees would be expected. If major either works revised to avoid damage or alternatively, a tree removal application be submitted. The site arborist is to report the assessment to Council to consider for approval prior to undertaking.

The draft Condition above requires clarification and/or refinement by Tree Management Officers. I'm Sure they've covered this before. There is something of a major impact for the cutting of roots over 50dia and the method for cutting roots.

Please reply condition for my information.
