Due to time constraints unfortunately I have been unable to prepare the lengthy submission I had hoped for.

However, as a member of the family whose property is neighbouring the vast majority of the proposed solar project, I again submit my firm OBJECTION to this project.

This project MUST be considered as part of the cumulative effect that all the renewable projects, temporary accommodations and EnergyCo transmission lines within the CWO REZ, will have on our small community. The sacrifice this project is making us provide, all for the energy to be transported back to the eastern coast, is far too great. The social impacts are already causing rifts within our community, let alone the concerns I have around safety for myself and my baby due to the increased traffic and number of people within our area should the project go ahead. The expectation for neighbouring landowners to agree to the terms of the project is disgraceful, and it seems unfair that the decision for this project to be approved is being made by people who seemingly do not come from a farming background- how does that deem them appropriate to decide how valuable this land is to the agricultural industry of our country? This solar project will have a negative impact on my family's farm, due to erosion from run off in wet periods, increase in public liability and insurance, increased risk of grass and bush fires, decreased value of our property... the list goes on.

Visually, this project will be an atrocity in our beautiful valley. I am devastated by the thought of raising my children in such conditions, not being able to give them the beautiful, safe environment to grow up in that myself, my siblings and my neighbours had.

Please please please do not let this project go ahead. I fear the mental health of those of us involved cannot take much more of this.
