I am writing to support the ending of native forest logging in NSW. Nearly 1000 of our unique native animal and plant species which exist nowhere else in the world, such as the endangered such as the Greater Glider and being pushed into the brink of extinction by this logging in NSW which has being continued unabated under both Liberal and Labor governments for years. This logging amongst the highest in the entire world and comparable in scale to the Amazon logging in Brazil. The wood pulp made from this logging is shipped to Asia into to make low value products like cardboard or toilet paper. Or even worse the wood isn't collected at all and left to rot on the ground.
