I have asked Jean McKern to write a submission on my behalf as I am Italian and do not have good written English.

I am a grandpa living with my wife and son at the top of [REDACTED]. I have serious health issues and the loss of a leg has confined me to a wheelchair. I like nothing better than taking my grandchildren for rides down the road on my wheelchair when they visit us.

Our neighbours keep us informed regarding Plasrefine. I am distressed to hear that, although no trucks will be permitted to use Beaconsfield and part of Braddon, there will be 140 x 2 employee vehicles making their way to and from the Factory each day. How can I take my wheelchair onto the road safely if they are permitted to use Beaconsfield and Braddon for access?

Why are Plasrefine trucks allowed to use Braddon Road at all? Access should be totally within the site as should the shield trees which will be planted on the adjoining land.

My wife and I chose to build at the top of the hill for the peace and quiet and rural outlook. We are happy here. A Plastic Waste Factory, built close by will change all that with noise, sight, toxic emissions pollution. I worry for our grandchildren who will not want to visit their grandparents if the Factory goes ahead.

Why did the State Government think it was a good idea to build such a large factory in the middle of the Southern Highlands?
