Here, at the top of Beaconsfield we are all upset at the prospect of having a Plastic Waste Recycling Facility, and all the pollutions that will accompany it, in our back yard.

I do not think it is right that the State Political Party can over-ride our Local Government plans for sustainable development in the SHIP.

Wingecarribee Council, past and present, has supported the residents. But how can it police the 140 x 2 employee vehicles which will make Beaconsfield Road their access to and from the factory daily. Beaconsfield is a popular walking, cycling, and horse riding road. It is currently a "no through road" making it safer for users. Once the North/South Road is built it will attract all the hoons in the district as witnessed in Redfields Road industrial development over on the other side of the railway line.
