I was born and raised in the Southern Highlands and have raised my own four children in the area. My grandparents built a house very close to the proposal nearly 100 years ago and today my 83yr old Uncle still resides there tending his cows.

I strongly object to the proposed plastic recycling refinery in Moss Vale. My concern is that the site is too close to residential areas, a school, a childcare centre and the ABR - Australian BioResources). The proposal will bring increased heavy traffic to an area that already struggles to cope with inadequate road infrastructure. I am very concerned with the fact that recycling refineries are usually classified as heavy industrial, due to the risk of air/water pollution in the event of the failure of safety processes and the high risk of fire. The site is located close to riparian zones to streams that feed into the Wingecarribee River, which feeds in Warragamba Dam (which provides drinking water to Sydney)

The potential environmental impact of air pollution from the stacks is a real concern, how will these emissions be safely monitored and what will be done if they are found to be over safe limits ?

I object to this proposal mainly because of the Location and scale of the project, the Traffic issues associated with it, the environmental risks it could pose and the effect on our community.
