I object to Moss Vale Plastic Recycling Facility development.

The loud, continuous hum, clanking sounds and engine noise from trucks arriving and departing will create a highly unpleasant environment, particularly during the late hours when most residents want peace and quiet.

In addition to the noise, the bright, glaring lights from the refinery also contribute to light pollution, disrupting the natural darkness of the surrounding environment. These lights, particularly at night, will flood nearby homes and open spaces, interfering with sleep patterns and diminishing the quality of life. The constant illumination also negatively impacts local wildlife, disrupting their natural nocturnal behaviours.
