I am writing to strongly object to the recommended approval of the Plasrefine facility in Moss Vale. After a careful review of the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure's (DPHI) assessment, I believe there are significant flaws in the evaluation process that warrant the rejection of this proposal.

While I have several concerns about the proposed facility, I will highlight my main objections below:

- 1. The potential environmental impact of air pollution from the 'stacks' (or vents) in the event of a malfunction or failure of the current air filtration system. If the system fails, the emissions could include volatile organic compounds (VOCs) or other hazardous toxins that may pose a serious threat to human health and the environment.*
- 2. The facility is situated too close to residential areas, within approximately 200 meters. This proximity poses a high risk to human health, residential properties, and local wildlife in the event of a fire or other emergency.*
- 3. Increased heavy vehicle traffic will generate noise pollution, air pollution, dust, and vibrations. Additionally, there is a risk of accidents, fatalities to wildlife, the potential introduction of invasive species, and accelerated degradation of local roads.*
