As a resident of Moss Vale for over 10 years, I would like to add my voice to the widespread objections to the Plasrefine plastics reprocessing facility planned here. My objection is based on the following issues:

- Microplastics are a huge issue for the world & this will add to them in our locality*
- The facility will risk polluting our waterways & drinking water (& Sydney's)*
- 100 large truck movements every day will clog Moss Vale's already choked road system - rush hours are a nightmare already*
