*I object on the grounds of visual impacts, not in keeping with the SHIP enterprise park, it is heavy industrial with high risk of pollution and fire. Increased traffic will create noise 24/7, pollution, accidents, killing of wildlife, damaging roads, deterring tourist (our major income stream), close to several school and childcare centres. Hire risk of fire, 17 fires in plastic refineries in Australia from 2019 to 2022, we have limited fire resources and no HAZMAT in the Highlands. Removal of habitat for endangered species, risk of micro and nano plastics to groundwater and streams feeding into the water supply of locals and Sydney. Danger to platypus habitat downstream from plastic particles and increased risk of sedimentation from runoff from hardstand areas. Risk of pollution from trucks loading and unloading particularly during the many high wind days in the highlands. Visual impact for residents of Beaconsfield Road, however, the monstrosity will be visible from further afield, including the tourist lookout at Bowral and the Briars, a popular spot for tourists.*
