*For many years, I owned a transport and distribution company and was a founding member of what today is called the SCLAA.*

*The proposed facility plans to process up to 120,000 tonnes of plastic each year, which equates to 6,000 semi trailer loads.*

*The vast majority of this plastic will come from Sydney.*

*Given the ever increasing need to lower emissions, why would the Planning Commission think that unnecessarily locating such a facility at least 100kms away from the major source of plastic it will process is a good idea?*

*I suggest that it be located as close as possible to the major source of plastic, which will minimise transport costs, and at a time of climate crisis, help reduce emissions.*

*In any planning today, transport efficiency which helps reduce emissions must be a major consideration.*
