I am writing to express my strong objection to the recommended approval of the Plasrefine facility in Moss Vale. After careful review of the Department of Planning and Housing and Infrastructure's (DPIE) assessment, I believe there are significant failures in the evaluation process that warrant rejection of this proposal.

This facility is too close to residential areas and represent a high risk to human, wildlife and residential property in the event of fire.

There will be significant increase to heavy vehicle traffic that will produce significant increase to pollution, noise, road degradation and risks of accident.

Schools and childcare facilities should be protected from the risks associated with this type of industry. As these facilities currently exist within 2km this surely is an inappropriate site.
