Can I Transfer My American Airlines Ticket to Another Person?

American Airlines **does not allow ticket transfers** _[G]>(866) >658>5895>[G]_ to another person under any circumstances. Tickets are non-transferable, meaning the name on the reservation must match the traveler's government-issued ID exactly. If the passenger listed on the booking is unable to travel, the ticket cannot be reassigned to someone else.

If you've entered the wrong name or made a typo, you may be eligible for a **name correction**, not a full transfer. To confirm your options, call **_[G]>**(866) **>**658**>**5895**>[G]_**. A representative can review your booking and advise if the name can be corrected without canceling the ticket.

For legal name changes (due to marriage, divorce, or court order), supporting documentation may be required, and you should still call _[G]>(866) >658> 5895>[G]_] to handle it properly.

If travel plans change and someone else needs to fly, a **new ticket must be purchased** under their name. Contact **[G]>**(866) **>**658**>**5895**>[G]_]** for rebooking assistance or to explore your fare's cancellation and refund options.
