What Is Delta Airlines' Flight Change Policy?

Delta Airlines flight change policy is flexible and allows most passengers to change flights with varying levels of flexibility based on fare class and destination. - No change fees apply to most domestic and international tickets originating from the U.S.
- Same-day flight changes are permitted for a fee (varies by fare type)
- Basic Economy tickets usually cannot be changed

Does Delta Charge a Fee to Change Flights?

There are many options to this question as delta reservations no longer charges change fees on:

• Main Cabin, Comfort+, and First Class tickets for travel within the U.S., and on international flights from the U.S.

However, some tickets **do** carry fees, especially:

- Basic Economy (not changeable under most conditions)
- International travel not originating in the U.S.

What Is Delta's Same-Day Flight Change Policy?

A same-day flight change with delta airlines allows you to switch to an earlier or later flight on the same day as your original departure, (866) 658-5895 confirm with delta first. You must request this within 24 hours of your originally scheduled flight, and the new flight must occur on the same calendar day.

Delta offers same-day confirmed and same-day standby options:[G] (866) 658-5895 [G]

- Same-Day Confirmed Fee: Usually around \$75
- Same-Day Standby: No fee, but availability is limited

Elite members (like Medallion Status) may receive free or discounted same-day changes. For availability and rules, call **[G]** (866) 658-5895 **[G]**.

Can I Change a Basic Economy Ticket on Delta?

Typically, **Basic Delta Economy tickets cannot be changed [G] (866) 658-5895 [G]** once purchased. However, during certain waivers or special circumstances (like COVID-19), Delta has allowed flexibility. To check your eligibility, contact **[G] (866) 658-5895 [G]**.

How to Change a Flight on Delta Airlines

Delta Air Lines allows most passengers to change flights without a fee **[G]** (866) 658-5895 **[G]**, except those with Basic Economy fares, which are typically non-changeable after the 24-hour risk-free cancellation window. For eligible tickets—including Delta Main Cabin, First Class, and Premium fares—changes can be made easily online via the Fly Delta app or Delta.com under "My Trips." Passengers only pay the fare difference if the new flight is more expensive; if it's cheaper, the balance is returned as eCredit.

Refundable tickets offer the most flexibility, allowing full refunds when applicable. <u>Delta</u> also offers a same-day flight change option: travelers can confirm a new flight on the same calendar day for \$75, a fee waived for Gold, Platinum, and Diamond Medallion members. Same-day standby is free for all passengers on eligible routes. Award tickets booked with SkyMiles follow the same rules, with mileage adjustments applied.

Flight changes aren't allowed for Basic Economy award tickets. If online changes aren't available, especially for international bookings or third-party reservations, customers can call Delta Reservations at 1-866) 658-5895. Overall, Delta's flight change policy is traveler-friendly, offering flexibility, no change fees on most fares, and streamlined tools for managing trips.

There are three main methods to change your Delta flight:

- 1. Call Delta Support: Dial [G] (866) 658-5895 [G]
- 2. Use the Delta Mobile App
- 3. Log in to Delta.com and go to "My Trips"

Phone support is highly recommended for complicated changes, multi-passenger itineraries, or international flights.

Are Delta Flight Change Fees Refundable?

Delta Air Lines (866) 658-5895 no longer charges flight change fees for most Main Cabin and higher fares on flights originating in the U.S., Canada, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands, meaning there's typically no fee to refund.

However, if you do pay a change fee—such as on certain international or non-U.S.-originating non-refundable tickets—those fees are generally not refundable. Instead of returning the fee to

your original payment method, Delta issues an eCredit for the remaining value after the fee is deducted, which you can use toward future travel.

Refundable fares, on the other hand, offer full flexibility; if you cancel or change a refundable ticket, the full amount—including any change fee—is returned to your original form of payment. In cases where Delta initiates a significant change to your flight—such as a schedule change over two hours, a routing adjustment, or a downgrade—you may be eligible for a full refund, including any change fees already paid. Award tickets booked with SkyMiles generally follow similar rules: change fees are waived for most, but mileage differences may apply, and any refunded miles go back into your SkyMiles account. Basic Economy tickets remain an exception; they are non-changeable and non-refundable outside the 24-hour risk-free cancellation window. If you feel you were charged a change fee in error or qualify for an exception due to a Delta-initiated change, you can submit a refund request online.

While most standard change fees have been eliminated, the refundability of any fees paid depends on your ticket type, fare class, point of origin, and the reason for the change. For maximum flexibility, refundable fares or elite SkyMiles Medallion status provide the best options. Always check the exact fare conditions when booking to understand whether change fees are applicable or refundable for your trip.

If you've paid a flight change fee and then qualify for a refund due to a waived policy or flight cancellation, Delta may credit your account. **[G]** (866) 658-5895 **[G]** Always check with a Delta agent by calling **[G]** (866) 658-5895 **[G]**.

What Happens If Delta Changes My Flight?

If Delta initiates a schedule change or cancellation, passengers are often allowed to:[G] (866) 658-5895 [G]

- Rebook to a new flight with no change fee
- Request a refund or eCredit

If **Delta changes your flight**, you may be eligible for special options depending on the type and severity of the change. A **minor schedule adjustment** (such as a shift of less than 60 minutes) typically does not qualify for a refund or free rebooking. However, if Delta makes a **significant schedule change**—usually defined as a delay or time change of **over 2 hours**, a **change in connection city**, or an **equipment downgrade**—you may be entitled to a **full refund**, even on **non-refundable tickets**. In such cases, Delta typically offers the option to **accept the new itinerary**, **rebook a different flight** at no additional cost, or **request a refund** via their online

form. If your flight is **canceled**, Delta airlines reservation will either rebook you automatically or allow you to choose an alternate flight for free. **SkyMiles members** and **Medallion elites** may receive priority rebooking. It's important to check your **email or Delta app notifications**, as these changes are communicated in advance. If you disagree with the changes or they no longer meet your needs, you can call Delta Reservations to discuss alternate solutions. Always review Delta's **Schedule Change and Cancellation Policy** to know your rights and options.

Can I Change a Delta Flight Booked with Miles?

Yes, changes are permitted for award tickets:[G] (866) 658-5895 [G]

- No change fee for most U.S.-originating travel
- Miles will be redeposited if eligible

Yes, you can **change a Delta flight booked with miles (866) 658-5895** in most cases, thanks to Delta's flexible policies. For **SkyMiles award tickets**, Delta has eliminated **change fees** for flights originating in the **U.S. and Canada**, as long as they are **not Basic Economy fares**. You can make changes to your **award booking** through the **Delta website** or the **Fly Delta app** by accessing the "**My Trips**" section. If the new flight requires more miles, you'll simply pay the **mileage difference**; if the new flight is cheaper, the extra miles are typically **redeposited** into your SkyMiles account.

If you're a **Medallion member** (Silver, Gold, Platinum, or Diamond), you may receive **priority support** and **waived redeposit fees**, offering even more flexibility. For changes involving **international award flights** or **partner airlines**, different rules and restrictions may apply, so it's best to review the specific fare rules or contact **Delta Reservations** directly. Always confirm your options before finalizing changes to a **SkyMiles ticket**.
